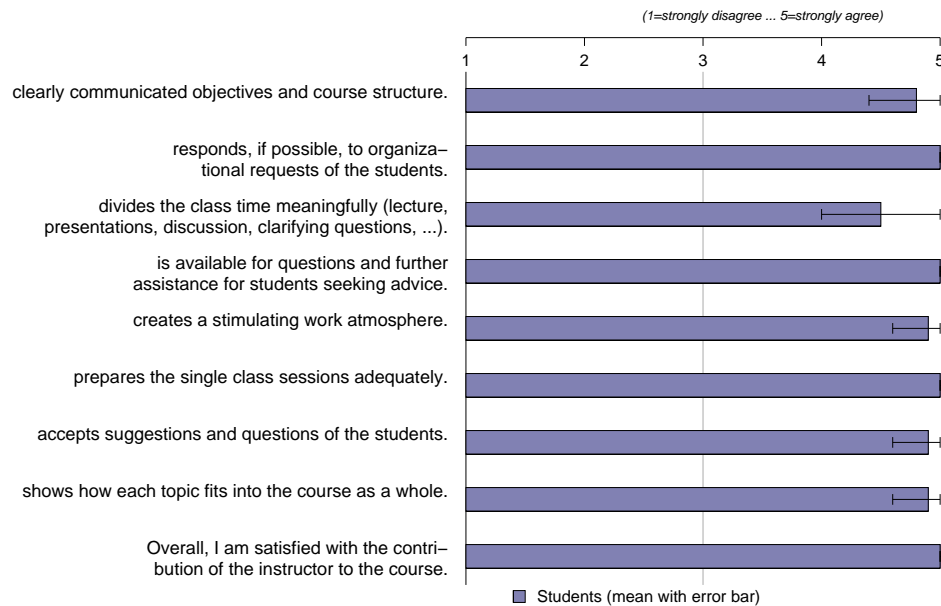

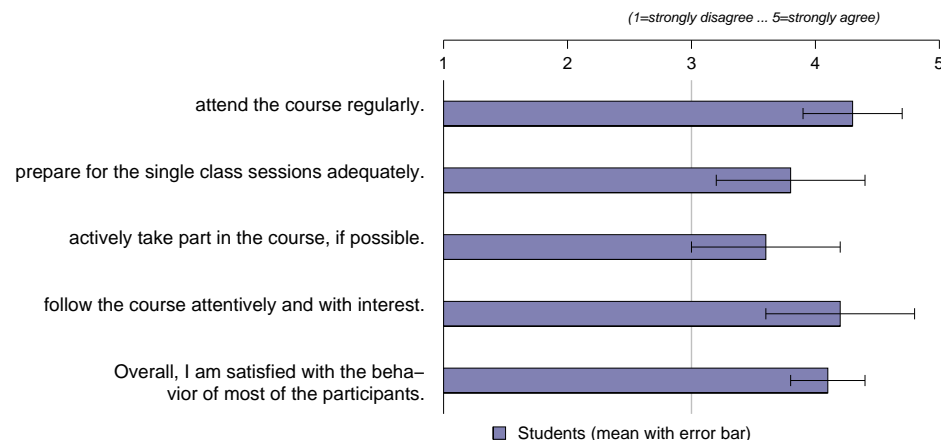

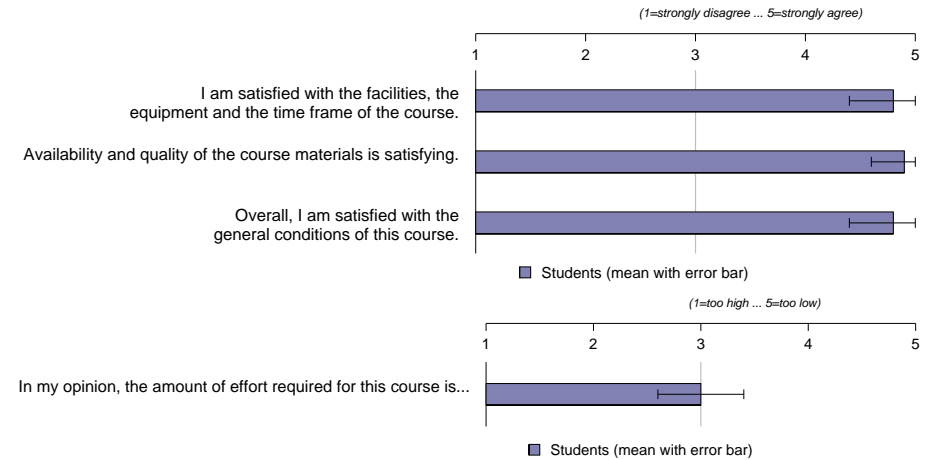


## Input of Participants
